POSITION PURPOSE

The C.O.P.E./Climbing Instructor is responsible for executing quality and safe C.O.P.E. and Climbing programs that provide campers and leaders an enjoyable and meaningful camp experience.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Instruct activities in which proficient.
- Use written lesson plans for each C.O.P.E. and climbing class taught.
- Assist with the maintenance, inventory, security, safety, proper recordkeeping, and use of all C.O.P.E. and climbing equipment and facilities.
- Be familiar with and enforce all safety rules and policies for C.O.P.E. and climbing areas.
- Maintain strict safety discipline at all times when campers, leaders, visitors, or staff are in the C.O.P.E. and/or climbing areas.
- Assist with setup and teardown of all C.O.P.E. and climbing facilities.
- Submit advancement and attendance records daily.
- Participate in all camp wide activities.
- All other duties as assigned.
